This is a very exciting topic, and we have lots of fun practical learning experiences planned. <u>Sumdog</u> is a fantastic games site that helps children learn mental strategies, and speeds up mental calculation skills. **This has been shown to have a real impact in the classroom**. The children will all have Sumdog codes in the front cover of their reading journals.

<u>Classdojo</u> is part of our in school behavior management system. It will email you weekly to tell you about your child's behavior and where they have earned the most points (working hard, listening carefully, being kind to others etc...). Accessing it at home will also allow your child to change their Avatars. On occasion we may need to hand out negative dojo's, these can be for incorrect uniform/PE Kit, no homework or bad behavior. Obviously, we like to focus on the positives and the vast majority of Dojos are handed out for good behavior and being well prepared.



<u>MATHS</u> –You can access <u>www.sumdog.com</u> for fun ways to help. We will be developing our understanding of numbers to 100 and place value this term

**ENGLISH** – This will be taught each morning, where the children will have a guided reading session, phonics session and English lesson.
